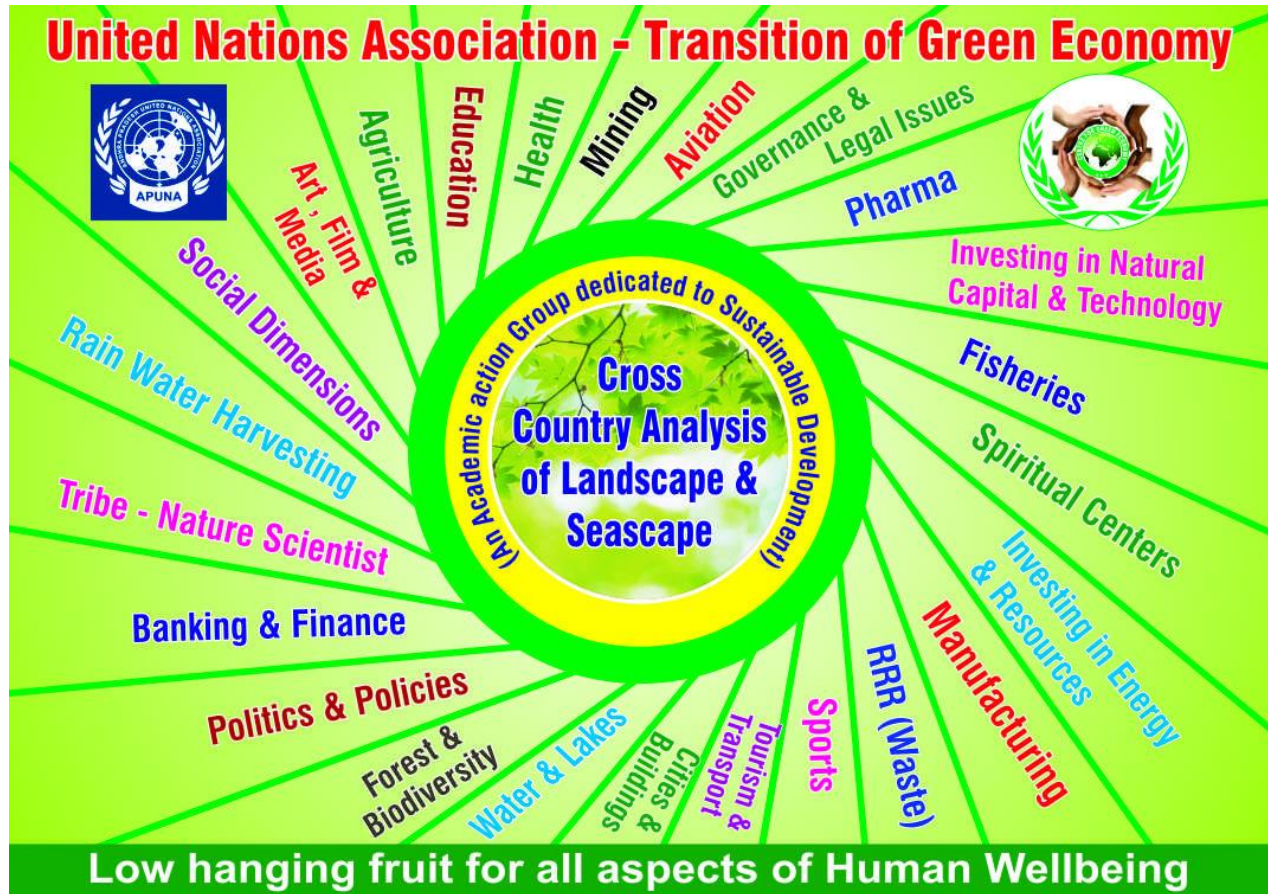


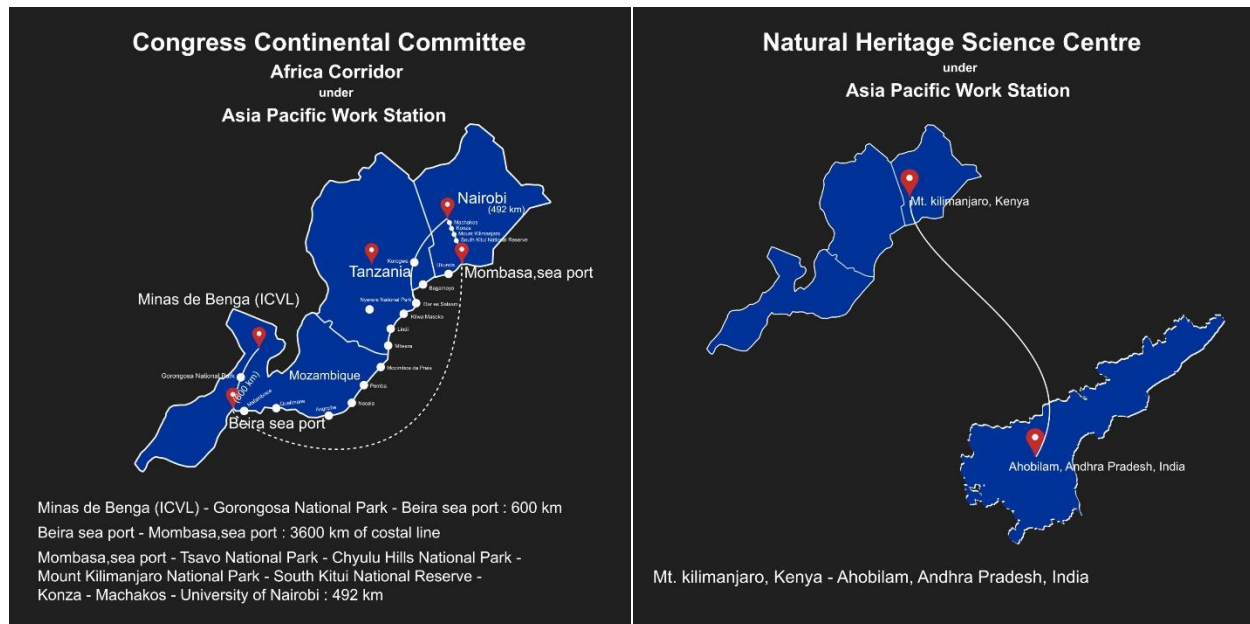
Introduction

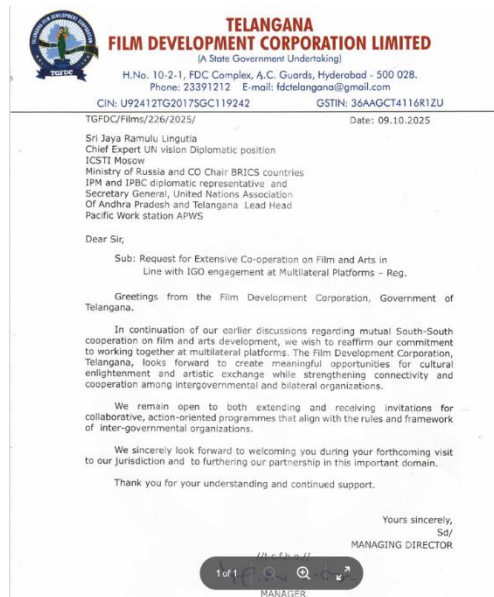
Mission

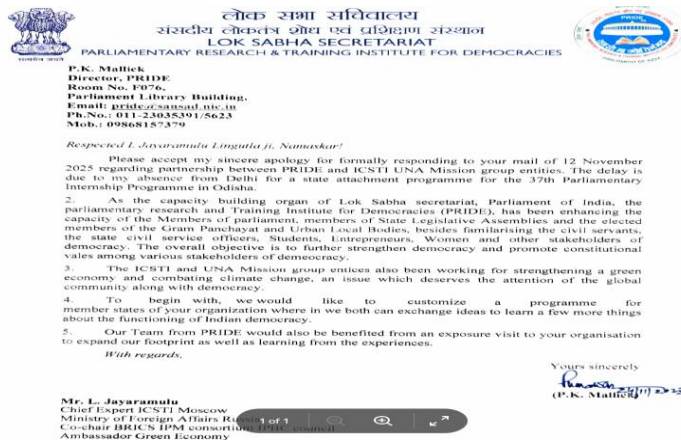
